Clinical Results Summary

Independent consumer-use evaluation (n = 31, 14 days)

Visible Skin Aging Results*

- Skin elasticity appearance improved after 14 days of use.
- Average skin elasticity improved by 9.3% from baseline.
- Facial wrinkle appearance scores were visibly reduced after 14 days.
- Average wrinkle appearance improved by 28.9% from baseline.

Wrinkle Appearance Score	3.8 ± 0.8	2.7 ± 0.7	28.9%

Blemish & Acne Appearance Results*

- Acne-prone skin appearance showed visible improvement after 14 days of use.
- A subgroup of participants showed up to 54.55% reduction in visible blemish count.
- Overall acne area and number of visible blemishes decreased compared to baseline.
- No adverse skin reactions were reported during the study period.

Parameter	Baseline (Day 0)	After 14 Days	Observed Improvement
Acne Area (mm ²)	53.3 – 65.2	48.3 – 62.1	Reduced appearance
Visible Blemish Count (pcs)	11 → 5	After 14 days	Up to 54.55%*
